The academic year 2021-22 was a fruitful year in the history of Academic Heights Public School, Ajarpura. A lot of curricular and co-curricular activities were conducted online and offline. Even at the time of Covid 19 studies at AHPS did not suffer. Over all development of every child was the focus. The target was achieved. Parents were impressed by performance of the school.

1. Online Meeting with parents

Online meeting with parents was conducted on 4th April 2021 to provide parents and students annual plan and give them detailed information on the online classes and assured them that the school will fully function even during covid 19 through online using Zoom Cloud Meetings. Mr. Samir Patel one of the trustees of the school was also present in this meeting and addressed parents. He requested parents to pay fee on time for a proper and regular functioning of school.

2. Orientation for KG section (offline)
